#### **ABOUT THE FILM**

A few days in May. Maciek (35) realises his life is pointless. Every day, he works from dawn to dusk only to pay the mortgage on his flat. As his boss treats him dishonestly, Maciek feels he's had enough. He steals his boss's car and spontaneously goes on a desperate joyride. He drives across Poland where people are preparing a celebration of an unspecified anniversary. In the meantime, Magda (35), a Town Hall employee, handles the organisation of the anniversary events. Highly committed at first, she gradually notices all the dirt and fiction around her. At some point, she must take a crucial decision whether she should accept it or risk her career and leave. Finally, on the celebration day, both protagonists meet for a moment. Can their meeting change anything?

## PRODUCTION COMPANY



TELEMARK is managed by two experienced creative producers: Anna Kępińska and Maciej Kubicki. They develop and produce creation documentary films, premium TV series, and arthouse cinema. They look for innovative ways of narration and contemporary stories with powerful characters shown in a formally inventive manner. Typically, TELEMARK seeks to develop projects in cooperation with creators who use a distinctive cinematic language. The company has collaborated with Agnieszka Holland, Wojtek Smarzowski, Marek Lechki, Leszek Dawid, Michał Bielawski, Bartek Konopka, Agnieszka Glińska, Anna Kazejak, Kasia Adamik, Lidia Duda, Marta Prus, Jakub Piątek, and Jacek Borcuch.

It is the first company on the Polish market to have produced premium feature series for HBO Europe: three seasons of *Bez Tajemnic* (a Polish adaptation of *In Treatment*) and two seasons of *Pakt* (*The Pact*). Other series made by TELEMARK are *Londyńczycy* (*Londoners* for TVP1), *Nielegalni* (*Illegals* for CANAL+ POLSKA), and documentary *Teen Mom Poland* (for MTV).

Anna Kępińska and Maciej Kubicki also produce creation documentary films. Their productions were awarded at the Kraków Film Festival (Marta Prus's *Over the Limit* in 2018,

Lidia Duda's *Entangled* in 2012) and the Koszalin Debut Film Festival (Marta Prus's *Talk to Me* in 2015). They were also screened at many Polish and international festivals, such as IDFA, Hot Docs, DOK Leipzig, Jihlava JIFF.

In 2019, TELEMARK produced *The Wind. A Documentary Thriller* directed by Michał Bielawski, a full-length creation documentary, in Polish-Slovak co-production with HBO Europe, Peter Kerekes, Kraków Festival Office. The film premiered internationally in the main competition of Visions du Réel in Nyon and opened the 2019 Kraków Film Festival.

Marek Lechki's *INTERIOR* is TELEMARK's full-length feature debut.

Anna Kępińska and Maciej Kubicki are members of the Polish Film Academy, the European Film Academy, and the Polish Guild of Producers. Maciej Kubicki is also an EMMY member.
