

## 14th CinEast Luxembourg – submit your film!

CinEast, the Central and Eastern European Film Festival in Luxembourg ([www.cineast.lu](http://www.cineast.lu)), has opened the call for entries for its 14<sup>th</sup> edition, which will be held from 7 to 24 October 2021 in the city of Luxembourg and other towns across the Grand Duchy.

The CinEast festival welcomes features as well as short films (fiction, documentary and animated) made by directors from the following countries only: *Albania, Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Georgia, Hungary, Kosovo, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia and Ukraine*. Exceptionally, other films having a strong connection to the mentioned countries can be considered.

The films can only be submitted via the [Filmfreeway](https://filmfreeway.com/CinEast) platform (<https://filmfreeway.com/CinEast>).

The submission deadline is **30 June 2021**.

### About CinEast

The CinEast festival aims to promote the cinema of Central and Eastern European countries of the former communist bloc. The Festival, held annually in Luxembourg, has existed since 2008 and the upcoming 14<sup>th</sup> edition (7-24 October 2021) plans to showcase around 50 feature films and 30 short films (fiction, animated and documentary). The festival also boasts a rich programme of accompanying events, including concerts, exhibitions, debates, culinary evenings etc. Selected feature films are included in the Official Competition to compete for the Grand Prix and the Special Jury Prize awarded by an International Jury, as well as the Critics' Prize awarded by a separate Press Jury. The audience votes for the Audience Award for the best feature film as well as three Audience Awards for short films – the best fiction, animated and documentary short film. In 2020, the CinEast festival – organised in “hybrid” format - attracted over 6450 participants. The Grand Prix awarded by the international jury presided over by Tomasz Wasilewski went to the film *Servants* by Ivan Ostrochovský.
